#### Question:

Should the City Council approve the purchase of a new generator for the Regatta Park Wastewater Pump Station?

#### Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends the Council approve the purchase of a new generator for the Regatta Park Wastewater Pump Station.

#### Authority:

Under LCMC 2.05.050 and City Manager ProTem contract terms the Council must approve procurement amounts over \$100,000.00. In this case, the generator cost is \$113,286.00. The procurement method is through Sourcewell.

#### Background:

The existing stand-by generator was manufactured in 1983 and is natural gas driven, which is not acceptable under current Department of Environmental Quality standards. New parts are no longer available. Funds to purchase a new generator were approved in the Fiscal Year 2025/26 budget, however, staff requested a new generator for Canyon Park Pump Station and the request should have been for Regatta Park Pump Station.

#### Council Options:

Approve the new generator to replace the outdated generator at the Regatta Park Wastewater Pump Station.

Do not approve the new generator to replace the outdated generator at the Regatta Park Wastewater Pump Station.

#### Financial Impact

A new generator was approved for \$100,000 in the Fiscal Year 2025/26 budget, the remaining 13,286.00 would come from contingency.

#### Potential Motions:

Move to Approve the new generator to replace the outdated generator at the Regatta Park Wastewater Pump Station for \$113,286.00

Move to deny purchase
